



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITAS VETERAN BANGUN NUSANTARA
SUKOHARJO
AND
UNION INSTITUTE OF LANGUAGE (UIL) AUSTRALIA

The Universitas Veteran Bangun Nusantara Sukoharjo, of Jl. Letjen. Sujono Humardani No. 1 Gadingan Jombor, Bendosari, Sukoharjo Jawa Tengah 57521, Indonesia and the Union Institute of Language, of Level 2, WKC, 37 Sinnathamby Boulevard, Springfield, Queensland, Australia, 4300 hereinafter referred to as "the Parties";

WHEREAS, The Universitas Veteran Bangun Nusantara Sukoharjo and the Union Institute of Language (UIL), Australia agree to cooperate on exchange programs based on reciprocity, exchange programs shall promote the mutual understanding between the respective faculty, students, and scholars of the Parties;

DESIRING to enhance the existing friendly relations between the two institutions and through development of cooperation in the field of education;

BELIEVING that the cooperation would benefit the Parties;

PURSUANT to the prevailing laws and regulations in their respective countries as well as the procedures and policies on basic educational cooperation.

HAVE REACHED THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING:

ARTICLE I - OBJECTIVES

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to promote mutual cooperation in education and training on a reciprocal basis and to promote mutual cooperation for the advancement of knowledge and intellectual development.

ARTICLE II - SCOPE OF COOPERATION

This MoU has scope of cooperation as follows between the two institutions:

1. To facilitate:
 - a. Cooperation in the exchange of information relating to their scholarly activities in fields of mutual interests;
 - b. Promotion of appropriate joint scholarly activities;
 - c. Encouragement of students and staff to spend periods of time in the host institution. The exchange of students will be dependent upon the execution of a formal Student Exchange Agreement mutually agreed between the parties in writing prior to commencement of this activity;
 - d. Conducting of cultural projects, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties, prior to commencement of this activity;
 - e. Conducting of customised Study Tours that may form part of the student's curriculum, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties, prior to the commencement of this activity;
 - f. Provision of study abroad opportunities at undergraduate and graduate level as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to the commencement of this activity.

ARTICLE III - IMPLEMENTATION

The Parties shall implement the MoU through specific arrangements, programs or projects in accordance with available funds of the Parties and shall form an integral part of this MoU.

ARTICLE IV - FUNDING

The cost of the cooperative activities under this MoU shall be funded on terms to be mutually determined by the Parties and shall be subject to the availability of funds and the specifics of the project.

ARTICLE V - SUSPENSION

Each Party reserves the right, for reasons of security, to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implementation of this MoU which shall be effective sixty (60) days after notification has been given to the other party, through government institutions.

ARTICLE VI - CONFIDENTIALITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

1. The Parties shall ensure that the educational data, information, and intellectual property rights mutually provided and developed which are carried out under this Memorandum of Understanding, shall not be transferred or supplied to a Third Party without the prior written consent of the other Party.
2. In case of specific arrangement, program or project may result in intellectual property; the Parties shall conclude a separate arrangement in accordance with their respective laws and regulations.

ARTICLE VII - SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute arising from the implementation of the provisions of the MoU shall be settled amicably by consultations or negotiation, through government institutions.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENT

This MoU may be reviewed and amended at any time, by mutual written consent of the Parties. Such revisions or amendments shall come into effect in accordance with the provision on entry into force.

ARTICLE IX - DURATION AND TERMINATION

- (1) This MoU shall remain to have effect for a period of 5 (five) years and may be extended for the same period by mutual consent of the Parties through government institutions.
- (2) The termination of this MoU shall not affect the validity and duration of any arrangements, programs, activities or projects made under this MoU until the completion of such arrangements, programs, activities or projects.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their respective schools, have signed this MoU.
